Sign Ordinance/Septic Regulations



Lakeville

One sign shall be allowed per street frontage. Within residential districts, no sign shall exceed 12 square feet in area and 6 feet in height for single-family, two-family, townhouse, and quadraminium units.

Directional on-premise signs shall not be larger than 4 square feet. The number of signs shall not exceed 4 unless approved by the city council. Off Premises signs shall be limited to situations where access is confusing and traffic safety could be inappropriately routed through residential streets. The size of the sign shall be approved by the city council and such sign shall contain no advertising.

No signs are allowed within the right-of-way, whether temporary or during the course of a property sale.

Septic System Regulations

City follows Dakota County regulations, as well as Rule 7080.
