Saint Paul Park Regulations

These Regulations have been taken directly from the city's website. Information deemed reliable but not guaranteed. Please consult government websites for most current regulations.

Sign Ordinance Regulations

Individual property sale, lease or rental signs are permitted. Such signs must be removed within ten days after the sale or rental of property. Such sale, lease or rental signs may not measure more than four square feet in R-1 and R-2 districts; not more than 32 square feet in R-3, R-4, R-B, B-1, B-2, B-3, B-4 and I-1 districts; and not more than 50 square feet in the I-2 district. There shall be only one such sign per property. Corner properties, however, may contain two signs, one per frontage.

Any signs which obstruct the vision of drivers or pedestrians or detract from the visibility of any official traffic control device are prohibited.

No signs other than governmental signs shall be erected or temporarily placed within any street rights-of-way or upon any public lands or easements or rights-of-way.

Septic System Regulations

Septic systems are managed by Washington County.
